The Green Recovery Enterprise Clinic is part of the **Green Recovery Forum: Leveraging the contributions** of MSMEs to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals, an effort to bring MSMEs potential and contribution to Green Recovery to light by connecting a growing regional network of MSMEs, and intermediaries with policy makers and other key stakeholders. 
